Dear Parents/Guardians

The School Council Policy asks that parents and students be aware of safety requirements and have written permission before riding or bringing a bicycle, skateboard, roller blades, roller skates, scooters etc. to school.

The requirements for the above to be used to travel to and from school are:

- Students should be at least 10 years old – unless accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Parents return a signed permission form.
- An approved helmet must be worn whilst riding (we also recommend wearing kneepads, elbow pads & gloves/wrist guards).
- The items are not to be used inside the school buildings or school grounds from 8:30am -4:00pm
- The items will be stored inside the bike shed during the day. The shed is usually kept locked during school hours.
- The items must be used safely, sensibly and legally.

If these rules are not followed, and wheeled transport is brought onto the school property, they may be impounded until collected by the student's parents.
